SANCTUARY



Located on 85 acres, Pasado's Safe Haven is home to approximately 200+ animals: dogs, cats and farmed animals, most of whom we rescued as victims of cruelty. They enjoy fresh air, green pastures, nourishing food, state-of-the-art vet care from our Healing Barn and, of course, lots of love! After receiving any medical care that is needed, almost all of our animals are available for adoption.

INVESTIGATIONS & RESCUE



Pasado's Safe Haven has nearly 25 years of experience responding to and investigating cases of animal cruelty. We are dedicated to getting justice for animals by investigating reports of animal abuse and neglect, collaborating with law enforcement on animal cruelty cases, and providing trainings for law enforcement, animal control and prosecutors.

Named after Pasado, a beloved donkey who was beaten to death by three teenage boys, Pasado's Safe Haven now fights so that other animals can live free from abuse, neglect, abandonment and exploitation.

Pasado's Safe Haven has a unique, comprehensive approach to ending animal cruelty. In addition to investigating animal cruelty crimes and providing sanctuary and rehabilitation to animals who have suffered from abuse and neglect, we also advocate for better laws to protect animals and work to educate the public about how they can help end animal cruelty.

PET HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION



Pasado's Safe Haven is preventing shelter overpopulation and unnecessary euthanasia through targeted spay/neuter programs serving income-qualified families. We have also started a unique pet food program that works in partnership with our spay/neuter program and human food banks. To date, we have performed over 55,000 spay/neuters, helping to lower the number of dogs and cats entering shelters.



EDUCATION & ADVOCACY



Each year, Pasado's Safe Haven engages thousands of people through online and sanctuary-based education and advocacy designed to reduce suffering and grow compassion. From public tours to our school program, people can connect directly with our sanctuary animals virtually and in-person.
